

Gay and Bisexual Men's Health Survey

East Midlands

This report is a supplementary report to the Stonewall report Gay and Bisexual Men's Health Survey. This report provides further regional statistics for each country and locality.

Methodology

In 2011, 6861 men responded to an online and paper survey on their health needs and experiences.

The survey included questions on lifestyle (alcohol consumption, drug use, exercise and mental health), common health needs (cancer, diabetes and heart disease) and experiences of the health sector. These are also included in the main report.

Guidance on using the data

This data is intended to provide the NHS and public health planners with information about their local population, in comparison to national and regional data. For nationwide statistics (Great Britain) for comparison, please refer to the main report.
